## JACK’S CORNER



### “DO I HAVE A SUBMISSIVE SPIRIT?”

When we look at our present world we often find it difficult to see those who are willing to submit to authority. And because of this, we see on-going problems and chaos.

In God’s word we are instructed to be submissive in various aspects.

- (1) Wives are to be submissive to husbands (I Pet. 3:5; Col. 3:18).
- (2) We are to be submissive to the laws of the land (Rom. 13:1; Tit. 3:1).
- (3) We are to be submissive to the elders of the church (Heb. 13:17).
- (4) We are to submit to one another in the fear of God (Eph. 5:21).

A lack of submission in these areas has caused divorce to run rampant. It is why our jails and prisons are filled to capacity. It is why there is unfaithfulness in church attendance. It is why brethren are often at odds with one another.

Obviously, if we are submitting, first of all to God, these problems could be solved.

So, how can we be more submissive?

- (1) By being clothed with humility (I Pet. 5:6).
- (2) By putting away carnal (worldly) thinking (Rom. 8:6-8).
- (3) By remembering Jesus’ example when He said, ‘...not as I will, but as You will’ (Mt. 26:39).

Humility is key to submission. Without it, the outcome will not be good because, *‘Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall’* (Prov. 16:18).
