

Zone Four Skeet Championship (11 – 13 August 2017):

The Zone Four Board of Directors has decided to conduct this year's shoot as an Internet based tournament (aka I-Shoot), each state's directors would determine the best location for their shooters to attend and work with the selected club to obtain their agreement to participate.

Here is a short abbreviated sequence of how an I-shoot is conducted:

Shooters will be directed to go to a web site and find the registration form

Shooters/squad determine what club they want to shoot

Shooters send registration form and deposit to the Zone organization (NOT the Club where they're going to shoot

Zone advises hosting clubs of entries as they receive them so clubs can set up squads

Host Clubs are responsible for running their shoot (An agreement with all requirements is provided to all clubs)

Day of shoot, clubs transmit shoot scores at the end of each flight to a web site

Web site provides a score board page that is updated with the receipt of scores from all clubs

Web site provides a shoot-off report

The entry fee to participate is \$48 per hundred targets.
