Misha is best suited to a quiet adult home that is not an apartment or a condo as she will bark when left at home alone. With further training this may cease. She should also be the only animal in her new home, and needs to be introduced to other dogs very slowly, as she tends to become dominant with other small dogs (we're not sure how she would be with larger dogs or cats). With time and proper training she may become more comfortable with other dogs.
