- 3. The Liturgical Year begins on the first Sunday of Advent and ends with the feast of Christ the King
- 4. The colours in the church change depending on the season

Advent and Lent – purple represents preparing for Christ and penance and renewal at Lent Christmas, Triduum and Easter – white represents joy and victory

Ordinary Time – green represents life and hope

Red is also used on Passion Sunday, Good Friday, Pentecost, Confirmation and some feast days
