- The church has a liturgical calendar
- There are six seasons – Advent, Christmas, Lent, The Triduum, Easter and Ordinary Time
- The Liturgical Year begins on the first Sunday of Advent and ends with the feast of Christ the King
- The colours in the church change depending on the season
Advent and Lent – purple represents preparing for Christ and penance and renewal at Lent
Christmas, Triduum and Easter – white represents joy and victory
Ordinary Time – green represents life and hope
Red is also used on Passion Sunday, Good Friday, Pentecost, Confirmation and some feast days
