Thursday was a day to relax some, talk with many friends we hadn't seen for some time, walk through the vendors, and make new friends. The hotel was very nice with easy access from our rooms to the convention hall and break-out rooms.

Friday of the Rally the six of us took a day ride to three suggested sites near Green Bay. Our first stop was at Doc's Harley Davidson 18 miles west of Green Bay in Shawano County. Doc has been in business as a Harley dealer since 1979. He also has turned the dealership into a museum of classic cars and motorcycles, with a bird and reptile atrium inside the dealership building. Outside the dealership there are a number of animals such as: peacocks and pheasants, tortoises, miniature horses, longhorn steers, emus, camel, giant rabbit, kangaroos, goats, pigs, alpacas, and gators. Other outside attractions include: a large Ferris wheel with motorcycles instead of seats, the Timeline Saloon & BBQ, Antique mall, another 1926 Motorcycle Museum, and the Hog Barn Banquet Hall. Our next stop was at Twig's Hand Crafted Specialty Soda in Shawano, WI. They create and bottle specialty sodas that they deliver throughout Wisconsin. We sampled a number of their sodas (all for free) and purchased some to bring home with us. They too had a very interesting display of the family history in developing their unique soda flavors. After lunch we returned to Green Bay to tour the National Railroad Museum. A very interesting museum that includes many historic trains that allow a person to sit in the engineer's seat, and a walk through passenger cars, diners, sleeper cars, etc. Most of the engines in the museum appeared larger than today's engines. I believe there were four complete trains in the building we visited. We didn't visit the other larger building or take the train ride as time and our energy was running down. 


