## Are You Interested In A **Storytime** ?

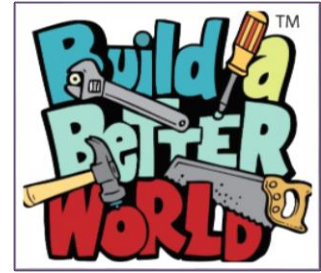
