### Regular Season Recap for BP Sports

With only 17 games remaining in the football season (11 NFL playoff games and 5 bowl games plus the National Championship), we thought it would be a good time to recap the season here at BP Sports. First, we couldn't wouldn't be here without your support and patronage. Again, we can't thank you enough that you took a chance on us in these first couple of seasons of BP Sports and for that we'll be forever grateful.

One year removed from an historically great season, it was NOT a good season on these pages especially on the college side where we finished an extremely disappointing 31-37-3. We are 17-13 in the bowls so far so hopefully it was more of an out-lie type of year. Rest assured we will be making some changes in our CFB handicapping process in 2020 as this season was unacceptable. On the positive side, the NFL remains super strong as we've never had a losing season in the NFL on these pages and we've never been below 56% in any season! That is extremely rare and it shows in the 5 year cumulative records (see page 3) as we're dominating the competition.

It does give us great pleasure that when you factor in the combined record in the last 5 years, we are the No. 1 most accurate newsletter (see page 3) in the regular season by far. It's not even close as we have a 27-game lead on the Sports Reporter in terms of overall net wins in CFB/NFL.

As with any season win or lose, there are still many lessons to be taken from this year. First and foremost, there are no guarantees in this industry and winning consistently is very hard to do. **Keep in mind, the Nevada sports books have now shown a profit in each of the last 75 months. Their last losing month came way back in July 2013.** That's some pretty stiff competition we're going up against every single week, month and year. With this sub-par season, we'll obviously try to learn from it as the market continues to evolve especially with the legalization nation wide brings more money and competition into the market place.

### Games in Rotation Order

**Thursday, January 2nd**

**Birmingham Bowl in Birmingham, AL**

1★ **Cincinnati (-7 -115).** † **Cincinnati 31 Boston College 23.** Even though Cincinnati is a Group of 5 team and BC is in a Power 5 conference, the two teams played similar schedules in terms of strength. The Bearcats statistically are the superior team with as they were +0.3 in ypp margin while the Eagles were -0.6. BC will have an interim coach here in Rich Gunnell (WR coach) as they surprisingly fired Steve Addazio after the season. Their O.C. also left for Northwestern. Finally, their top player RB AJ Dillon (1,685 rush yards, 14 TD's) is sitting this game out.

**Gator Bowl in Jacksonville, FL**

1★ **Tennessee (-2).** † **Tennessee 27 Indiana 24.** After a disastrous start to the season that included upset losses to Georgia St and BYU, Tennessee finished the season on a 7-3 SU run and they covered in 6 of their last 7 games. Meanwhile, Indiana had their best season in at least a quarter century but did lose their O.C. Kalen DeBeor who took the head job at Fresno St. However, he will still call plays here as Indiana tries for their first 9-win season in 52 years. Since 2015, Big Ten teams are 3-9 SU and 2-10 ATS against SEC teams in bowl games and we expect Tennessee to have the crowd edge here.

**Friday, January 3rd**

**Idaho Potato Bowl in Boise, ID**

1★ **OVER 58.5.** † **Ohio 34 Nevada 26.** It was a disappointing season for Ohio as they were preseason MAC East favorites but stumbled to a 6-6 finish. Statistically though, they were +0.8 in ypp margin (No. 34 in country) while their opponent here Nevada was -1.1 (No. 117) in that category. The Wolfpack will

be playing without 3 defensive starters who are suspended for this game after the UNLV brawl and a 4th starter is out for the first half. Ohio has won its last two bowl games by a combined score of 68-6. We're taking the OVER here as the early weather forecast (Sunny high 40's, low wind) is about as good as it gets in Boise this time of the year.

**Saturday, January 4th**

**Armed Forces Bowl in Fort Worth, TX**

1★ **Tulane (-7).** † **Tulane 32 Southern Miss 24.** Even though both of these teams are in the Group of 5, Tulane did play the much tougher schedule (No. 70 vs No. 109) and the Green Wave were the statistically superior team (+0.7 in ypp margin vs +0.4 for Southern Miss). Tulane does limp in here with 5 losses in their last 6 games but we think that gives us some value here.

**Monday, January 6th**

**Lending Tree Bowl in Mobile, AL**

1★ **OVER 55.5.** † **UL-LAFAYETTE 36 Miami, Oh 21.** To get a 2-TD spread in a lower-level bowl game obviously you need some huge statistical disparities. We have that here as ULL was +1.6 in ypp margin (No. 15) while Miami was -0.2 (No. 83). Despite their 8-win season, Miami was -3.5 in ppg and -75 ypg. Meanwhile, ULL was +19 ppg and +129 ypg. Note that in each of Miami's 5 losses this year, they lost by at least 14 points. Still, it's tough laying 2 TD's in a bowl game (see Miss St vs Miami, Oh a few years ago). We'll go with the OVER here as only 2 teams (Miss St and App St) have held ULL under 31 points this year.

# AFC/NFC Wild Card Forecasts

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Saturday, January 4th

**AFC Wildcard: Buffalo at Houston. 4:35pm ET on ESPN/ABC**

**1★ UNDER 43.5. HOUSTON 22 Buffalo 19.** Both teams took it easy last week as they had their playoff seeds pretty much locked up. Buffalo won 10 games in a season for the first time since 1999 and the Bills haven't won a playoff game since 1995. They win with defense as they were No. 3 in ypg allowed (298) and No. 2 in ppg allowed (16 ppg). Meanwhile, Houston is in the playoffs for the 4th time in 5 years. They will get the return of DE JJ Watt here. Houston did play the tougher schedule (No. 7 vs No. 29) but the Texans were -26 ypg on the season and were out-scored by a combined 7 points (not good for a 10-win team). We don't see much value here but will go with the UNDER. The UNDER cashed in 6 of Houston's last 9 games and Buffalo games saw the UNDER go 12-4 this season.

**AFC Wildcard: Tennessee at New England. 8:15pm ET on CBS**

**1★ New England (-5). NEW ENGLAND 26 Tennessee 20.** This is the first time since 2009 that New England is playing in the Wild Card round and note they've never reached the Super Bowl without a bye in the Belichick/Brady era. Last week Tom Brady threw his first "Pick 6" in two years. A lot of trends are backing the Pats here who come in off that historic upset loss to the Dolphins last week. Teams that are off straight up losses as a double-digit favorite: are 76-57-5 ATS (57%) the last 30 years. Since the Patriots first Super Bowl winning season, they are 42-22-2 ATS (66%) off a straight up loss since 2002. The Patriots off a home loss since 2002 are 15-5-2 ATS (75%). Finally, the Patriots with revenge since 2002 are 49-27-2 ATS (65%). This play would be even stronger for us but you have to respect what Tennessee has done with Tannehill at QB as they are 7-3 SU/ATS and are averaging 30 ppg on offense (just 16 ppg with Mariota at QB). Also you have to respect the NFL's leading rusher in Derrick Henry (1,540 yards).

Sunday, January 5th

**NFC Wildcard: Minnesota at New Orleans. 1:05pm ET on FOX**

**2★ New Orleans (-2 in a 6-point advantage teaser with Philadelphia). If you can't play a teaser, then 1★ New Orleans (-8).**

**NEW ORLEANS 30 Minnesota 21.** New Orleans could be one of the best wild-card team ever. Their 13-3 record is tied for the best ever for a Wild Card team and the Saints were +117 points on the season. Since Week 3 (remember they always struggle in Weeks 1 and 2 the last 6 years: 2-10 SU/1-11 ATS), the Saints were 12-2 SU (+9.5 ppg) and 11-3 ATS (+4.8 ppg). Meanwhile, Minnesota limped to the finish line this year especially a brutal MNF loss to the Packers at home a couple weeks ago. Minnesota was just 1-4 SU/ATS vs winning teams this year. The Saints were much better at home (+101 ypg vs -20 ypg on road) and they could remembering the "Minnesota Miracle" loss to the Vikings from a couple years ago. Still, we don't want to lay more than a TD here. We do think there is good value with the Saints on an advantage teaser with Philadelphia (crossing through key numbers of 7 and 3).

**AFC Wildcard: Seattle at Philadelphia. 4:40pm ET on NBC**

**2★ Philadelphia (+7.5 in a 6-point advantage teaser with New Orleans). If you can't play a teaser, then 1★ Philadelphia (+1.5).**

**PHILADELPHIA 22 Seattle 21.** Only two of Seattle's wins this year came by more than 7 points this year. Yes, we are fully aware that one of those was right here in Philly when Seattle won by 8 but note the Seahawks were +3 in TO's (Philly had a 23-14 first down edge). This isn't a great spot for Seattle after their 60-minute war with San Francisco on SNF and now they're traveling across the country. We feel Seattle is overrated as they are only +7 points this year and -7 ypg. Meanwhile, Philadelphia was +31 points this year and +28 ypg. We would like the Eagles even more here but they are even more compromised offensively losing 2 more starters vs the Giants last week. They still out-scored the G-Men 17-0 in the fourth quarter which cost us on these pages. While Philadelphia's injuries are well-publicized we're not sure the market is properly pricing Seattle's injuries.
