

## **Financial Secretary**

Worthy Brother Knights, It is hard to believe, but it is almost time for me to start sending out dues notices for next year. We still have not collected this year's dues from a number of members so, if you are one of those who has not yet paid, your dues notice will be higher than normal. Our council cannot sustain paying the Supreme and State Per Capita fees for the members who do not pay their dues. If you are experiencing hardship or just need extra time to

pay, please let us know and arrangements can be made. When you receive your dues notice, you only need to pay for <u>your</u> membership class that is highlighted at the top. You DO NOT need to pay for all the classification that are listed on the lower section of the dues notice.

Members who are <u>not</u> required to pay dues are, HONORARY LIFE, ACTIVE MILITARY, FULL TIME STUDENT or if you are DISABLED. If you fall into one of these categories, please send in a note or documentation in place of your dues notice. Honorary Life members, we know who you are and there is no need for any documentation. Also, as part of your dues notice, there will be two voluntary donation request, **10 for Charity** and the **Sacred Heart Major Seminary Scholarship Fund (SHMSSF)**. The 10 for charity is a \$10 donation that will be used for our state charity programs, and the SHMSSF is a \$6 donation that will be used to help offset the tuition cost for the students of Sacred Heart. Please consider donating to these two programs. We are still looking for someone to take over the Financial Secretary's position. I am looking to step back on my responsibilities and hopefully spend more time with family. The FS position does not require a lot of time but with my work schedule and my other volunteering it is getting to be too much and I am having a hard time keeping up with everything.
