

August 2015 ASQMV SLT Meeting Minutes Highlights

Education: The CBA class will run as planned. The registration numbers were below the breakeven point 1-2 days before registration was to close. The team mitigated that risk by opening up the registration date and sending an email blast with that notification as well as advertising the class for the first time on LinkedIn. As of 8/13/15 there were 8 registrants for the new ASQMV course exceeding breakeven. ASQMV is looking for avenues to partner with Quality Support Group (QSG) for educational offerings. QSG is interested in a 1-day education event and ASQMV will poll its membership for interest.

Programs: The 1st Thursday of September and October runs very early in the month. The SLT decided to change the dates to the 2nd Thursday of each of these months as a result. The speakers for the 9/10/15 meeting will be ASQ member Andy Moysenko who will present *A Quality Organization for Systems Enterprise*. ASQMV member and prior ASQMV SLT Jack Gale will present *The Checklist Manifesto* for the October 8 meeting. November and December planning is preliminary with ideas for ISO and another professional organization event for these months respectively. We hope to have a factory tour in the spring of 2016. Negotiations for a student event at the University of Massachusetts in Lowell are shaping up to be located at the campus.

Succession: Our Arrangements Chair and Webmaster will be finishing her leadership roles in September and December respectively due to her career goals. The SLT will share Arrangements tasks until a new chair comes on board. In planning for the future change in SLT positions for January 2016, the Chair will send out emails to see how/ if the SLT would like to change up positions for the new year.
