Today: Welcome back! The first day of Sunday School and Confirmation begins today! Everyone is invited to stay after Sunday School for a potluck meal.

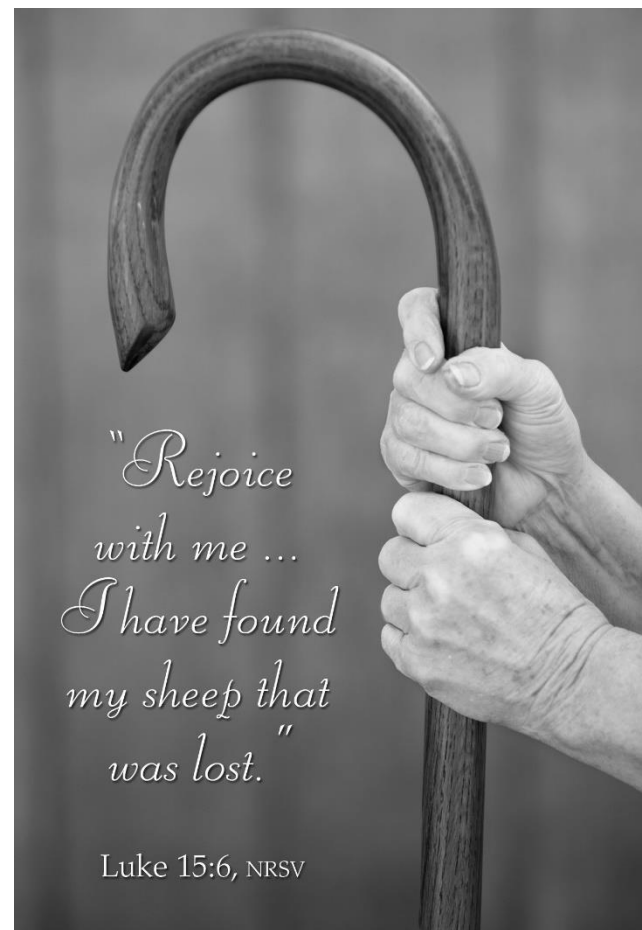
