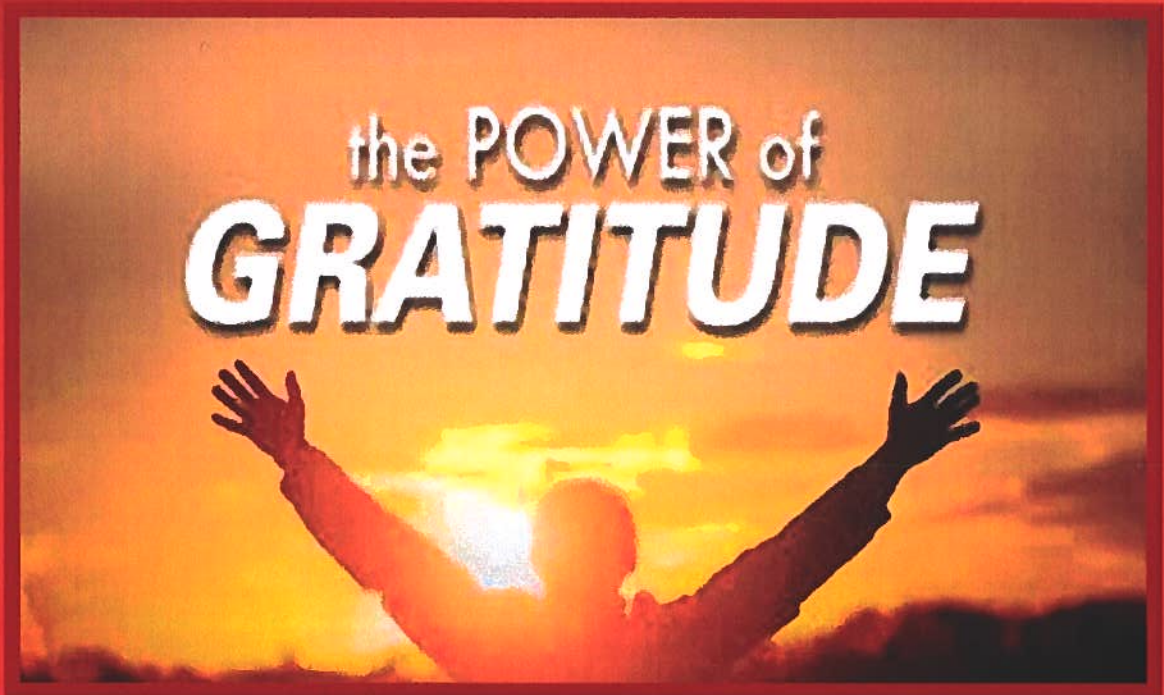

Rev. Ian Spencer

The Reverend Ian Spencer was born in Columbus, Georgia. He is the son of Mr. Carl Spencer and the late Hattie Spencer. At the young age of 16, Rev. Spencer acknowledged God's calling on his life and diligently began his work in the ministry. In 1993, he preached his initial sermon, "The World Needs Love" at the Carter Monumental CME Church. In 2005 Rev. Spencer graduated The Interdenominational Theological Center Extension Course with a certificate in Theology. In that same year, his dream came true; he was ordained a deacon, and in 2007, he was ordained Elder. Then in 2007, he attended Frontline Training Institute and received a certificate in Bible Doctrine and Bible Knowledge and Rev. Spencer is an alumni of Paine College with a bachelor's degree in History.

After ordination, he was assigned to St. Paul CME Church (2005-2008) to teach God's people. It was here that his great great-grandfather, the late Reverend G.W. Carlton, served as Pastor for many years. In 2009 Rev. Spencer was admitted into full connection. From 2008-2011, Pastor Spencer was sent to Byron Chapel CME Church and Little Union CME Church. His longest assignment thus far has been Pleasant Grove CME Church from 2011-2016. Rev. Spencer became the Shepard at Sidney Park CME Church in Columbia, SC in August 2016 and began a Children's Ministry that operated two Sundays per month. During the 2018 Seventh Episcopal District Annual Conference, Rev Spencer was transferred back to the Sixth Episcopal District where he currently pastors at St. Mary's CME in Elberton, GA

Rev. Spencer is a dedicated pastor, a God-fearing man, a man of prayer, a man of The Word, and a man that responds to the needs of every member - with sweetness and compassion.

In his free time, Rev. Spencer is a faithful supporter of the Gamecocks. Spencer lives by the motto, "Treat people as you would want them to treat you." His favorite scripture is John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

As a family man, Rev. Spencer is blessed with a beautiful and humble helpmate, Trinette Lynn Spencer, and they have two amazing children, Isom and Trinity. They currently reside in Elberton, GA.
