 - In what context will you use pastoral care skills?
 - What spiritual disciplines do you practice?
 - What was an important moment in your faith/spiritual journey?

Graduates of the two year program will be awarded Certificates of Completion and will be eligible to apply for Pastoral Care Specialist Level of membership in the AAPC (American Association of Pastoral Counselors).

Pastoral Care Specialists are trained and empowered to make hospital visits, telephone persons in need of contact, meet one-on-one with persons needing a listening ear for prayers and encouragement, offer support to grieving families. Graduates are also prepared to make appropriate referrals to professionals and programs for further care.

Pastoral Care Specialists are **NOT** qualified for long-term counseling or pastoral psychotherapy.

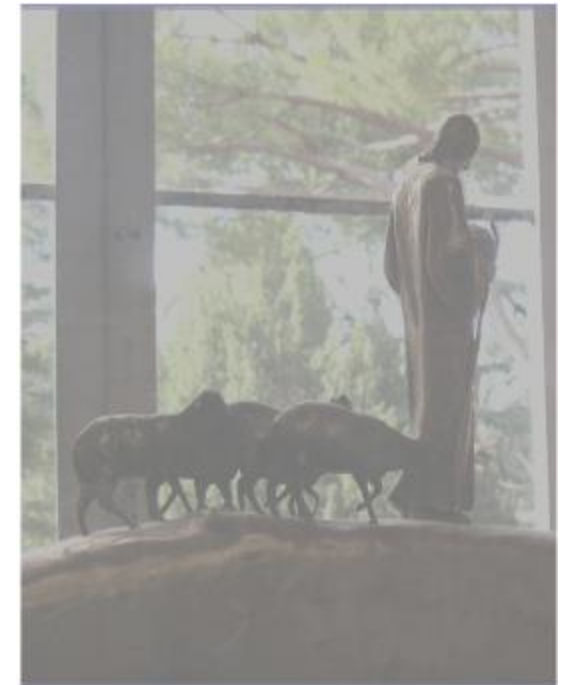

AAPC Accredited Training Program

A two-year training program designed for pastors, priests, students and lay pastoral care givers. PCS training seeks to strengthen professional/personal identity, spirituality and pastoral care practice. It integrates the resources of one's faith tradition with current theoretical understandings and practical counseling skills. PCS training components include didactic (lecture-based) teaching, clinical consultation and peer support. To maximize personal growth and learning opportunities, individual or group therapy is strongly encouraged.
