Modeled on Denver's successful Legal Night program, **Greeley Legal Night** was created to reach individuals in Weld County, where legal resources are scarce and the need for such resources is great. Greeley Legal Night is a project of the Colorado Lawyers Committee, the Spanish Speaking Lawyers Association of the Colorado Bar Association, Weld County Legal Services and other Weld County service providers.

NO PRIOR EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED. However, our greatest need is for family law and immigration attorneys. Our volunteer lawyers provide legal information and referrals for individuals and families that can't afford legal services. *Walk in clients are served on a first come first serve basis. Issues generally include consumer problems, immigration, employment, housing, and family law. Attorneys are paired with translators and other attorneys to conduct client interviews. Legal resource binders which include referrals in 15 areas of law are provided.*
