UPDATE ABOUT REOPENING OF CHURCHES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

St Anne has had approval from the Diocese to open for private prayer. Dates/Times below. Please note the following guidelines:

- Hand sanitisation occurs at entry and exit points.
- Social distancing is maintained in the church.
- If a pre-determined capacity is reached, you will be prevented entering the church. A "one in, one out" policy will be operated.
- People with cold or flu-like symptoms will be asked not to enter.

St Anne Westby: from 21st June

Sundays 12pm - 2pm, Wednesdays 9am -12pm

Holy Family: from 18th June

Tuesdays 10am – 12 noon, Thursdays 5pm till 7pm

Saturdays 10am – 12 noon

If you can't make the above times, local churches are open on the following dates/times:

Holy Trinity:

Mondays 10am to noon, Thursdays 2pm to 4pm

St Paul's, Warton:

Mondays 3pm to 4pm, Thursdays 5pm to 7pm

There is a requirement for Stewards/Ushers to supervise the comings and goings when our churches are open. The principal role of the usher is to ensure that social distancing is observed, and hygiene standards are maintained.

We need people to offer to be stewards/ushers who are known to the parish priest (possibly already signed up as volunteers for something else!) are not classed as vulnerable by current government guidance because of underlying health condition or age are not on a safeguarding plan are over 16 years old
