Car Line Information

Morning Car Line Procedures:

If you are using the parking lot to drop off your child, you must ESCORT your child across the crosswalk and into the front doors. Please make sure to use the front row of spaces for parking.

Afternoon Car Line Procedures:

Kindergarten:

Please make sure to remain in your vehicle and ensure that your signs are in the window for K4 and K5 pick-up. If your sign is not visible, you will be asked to park.

Elementary:

Any students who have not been picked-up by 3:40 must report to afterschool; a fee may apply.

Middle:

Any middle schoolers not picked up by 3:25 will be moved to the front of the school. Any students who have not been picked-up 3:40 must report to afterschool; a fee may apply.



Safety and Security

-No students will be dismissed after 2:15pm.

-Valid ID is required upon entrance to the school, and must be presented in order to sign-out any student.
