- > Easy Living Sophisticated, subtly-striped light-filtering vane style
- > Serene Linen-like vanes with a mylar coating to block out additional incoming light

> FABRIC COVERED HEADRAIL

Color-coordinating fabric covers the headrail, providing a seamless look from top to bottom.

control options

> STANDARD CONTINUOUS CORD LOOP CONTROL

The easy-to-operate continuous cord loop control allows you to open, close, and tilt the vanes as well as lift and lower the shadings for precise light control and privacy.

> TWO-ON-ONE HEADRAIL

Covers large expanses by placing two shades

that operate independently side by side on the same headrail.

> UNDERSIZE TILT ONLY SHADINGS

Available on window shadings 6" to 11 7/8" in width, ideal for narrow windows such as sidelights.

> REMOTELIFT MOTORIZATION

Opens, closes, lifts and lowers shadings at the touch of a button. No dangling cords. Two systems available:

Infrared (IR) – value choice that is ideal for operating individual shadings from up to 30 feet away. Requires line of sight positioning.

Radio Frequency (RF) – robust system with enhanced programming that is ideal for independent or grouped operation of multiple shadings. Remote control operates from up to 90 feet away with no line of sight required.

Hardware and Installation

- > Contoured headrail and bottom rail both are color coordinated to blend in with the shadings.
- > Optional back cover available to conceal the open rear side of the headrail for a more pleasing exterior look. Use of the back cover adds ¼" to minimum inside mounting depths.
- > Optional dust cover available to help shield the fabric and internal headrail components from dirt, dust and other contaminants.
- > Snap-in brackets easy to install and hold shadings securely in place. Quick release front lever allows for fast and easy shade removal.
- > Cord tensioner installation kit functions as a safety device that makes the lift cord less accessible to children and pets. Must be installed for the cord control to function properly.
- > Spacer blocks, extension brackets, hold-down brackets also available upon request to provide additional clearance.
- > Magnetic hold-down brackets provide stability and prevent swaying by securing the bottomrail in place. Often used for French Door applications. Standard with tilt-only shadings.
