

TWIG & STRING

Crochet Patterns

MICKEY UTILITY POUCH

GETTING STARTED

FINISHED SIZE

- Approximately 6.5" x 4.25" (may vary with yarn, tension & hook size)

MATERIALS

- Yarn (Pictured: Yellow (70% acrylic/30% wool, 1-ply, medium weight); Red, Black, White (100% cotton, 4-ply, medium weight)
 - Yellow (25 yards)
 - Red (40 yards)
 - Black (45 yards)
 - White (2.5 yards)
- One 7" zipper
- Tapestry needle
- Polyester stuffing

HOOK

- One size G/6 (4.0mm) crochet hook (or size recommended on ball band if using different yarn weight than pictured)

SKILL LEVEL

- Beginner

POUCH

With Red ch 26

Round 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 23 sts, 2sc in last st. Turn work and sc in back lps of beg ch. Sc in next 24 sts, 2 sc in last st. (52 sc around)

Rounds 2-12: sc around.

Rounds 13-17: With Black sc around.

Round 18: sc around, sc in next 4 sts, ch1, turn.

Rows 19-26: sc in next 26 sts, ch1, turn.

Row 27: sc across. Fasten off leaving 8" tail for sewing. Fold flap back and sew to WS of pouch where Red meets Black.



FEET (MAKE 2)

With Yellow ch 2

Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker at beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: (sc in first st, 2 sc in next st) 6 times. (12 sc)

Round 3: (sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 6 times. (18 sc)

Round 4: (sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) 6 times. (24 sc)

Rounds 5-10: sc around. (24 sc)

(Note: In the next section you will work "Short Rows" which means that you will turn before you have completed the entire round. Begin working in the round again when the pattern line begins with "Round")

Rows 11-16: sc in next 12 sts, turn, ch1.

Round 17: sc in first st, pm to mark first st, sc in next 11 sts, sc 3 sts evenly down side of short row section, sc in next 12 sts, sc 3 sts evenly up side of short row section.

Round 18: sc in first st, pm to mark first st, sc in next 11 sts, sc3tog (*the 3 sc that you made down the short row side*), sc in next 11 sts, sc3tog (*the 3 sc that you made up the short row side*). (25 sc around)

Note: If you end up with more or less than 25 sc around after Round 18 simply add or decrease what you need on round 19 (you won't be able to tell, I promise!).

Rounds 19-20: sc around. (25 sc) Place marker at beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 21: (sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog) 6 times, sc in next st.

Round 22: (sc in next st, sc2tog) 6 times, sc in next st. Stuff foot.

Rounds 23-33: With Black sc around. (13 sc)

Round 34: sc in next 17 sts. Fasten off leaving about 6" tail for sewing. Lightly stuff leg.

BUTTONS (MAKE 2)

With White ch 2

Round 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook.

Round 2: 2 sc in next st, 2 dc in next st, 2 sc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, 2 sc in next st. (12 sts around). Fasten off leaving 6" tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach buttons to RS of pouch as shown in picture.

Attach legs to bottom of pouch.

Sew in zipper (optional).

Weave in ends.
