

MY LITTLE SISTER'S DOUGHNUT SHOP IN OSWEGO WORTH THE TRIP!

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There is one place in the Village of Oswego that not only the locals but those from far and wide come to – My Little (or more accurately, My Lil) Sister's Doughnut Shoppe, located in a cute very small historic building downtown at 25 S Madison Street (331/203-2736).

Donut lovers can't sit and dine, since there is no seating! It's strictly a pick up and go kind of place. And yet, the business is brisk Monday through Saturday from 5:30 AM to 1 PM.

In good weather, they may carry their goodies to the nearby Hudson's Crossing Park on the Fox River a block or so to the west; or in any weather, to their cars where they will quickly wolf down their delicacies with no thought to the crumbs.



There are really five sisters, but typically, either Betsy Kammerer or Chris McClemons are on hand to help customers.

Established in 2012, My Sister's Lil Doughnut Shoppe features not only donuts, but also pastries and sweets (like the Oreo topped Long John with cream filling made with whipped cream and crushed Oreos, Powdered Cake or Glazed Donuts, Tiger Tails, Cinnamon Twists, Coffee Cake, Brownies, Turnovers, Strudel or Carrot Cake). Drinks include a 20 oz coffee for \$1.89, a 12 oz coffee for \$1.69, Milk or Hot Chocolate for \$1.89 or Apple or Orange Juice for \$1.69.

A Senior Special features one donut and small coffee for only \$2.00. A dozen donuts will only set you back \$11.00.

There are donut lovers from all over (even as far as from Chicago) who travel with their families to conduct "The Great Chicagoland Donut Hunt"; most agree that Oswego's My Little Sister's Doughnut Shoppe offers some of the very best selections to be had.

Plus, people think the store is "cute" and that the door looks like something out of a Disney movie.

There is typically a Special of the Month; Gift Certificates are available for purchase and there is limited off street parking. Visit the shop the next time you are in downtown Oswego and mention that you read about them in this newspaper.
