- Corral footing project all sites with corrals in the "Palmyra Loop" have all had their footing upgraded! The DNR will continue to get as many done as possible before May.
- A section of bridle trail near Hwy Z will be rerouted due to rutting/erosion
- Wilton Rd/Mueller Homestead rest stop please run the water for a few minutes if you are there, this will help keep the lines clear and bacteria levels in check
- The DNR has purchased a Bobcat Toolkit, and will be able to do more trail maintenance and complete work such as cleaning manure pits faster with the additional equipment. If pits are full, call 262-594-6220
- Mini Library is at DNR maintenance shop, we do have permission to mount it in the Pavillion
