The Texas State Board of Education (SBOE) determines evaluation of instructional material annually by issuing a proclamation. Based on the instructional materials adoption cycle established by the SBOE, Lewisville ISD (LISD) is conducting evaluation of instructional materials issued under [Proclamation 2015](#)

LISD believes parent involvement in this process is essential. Instructional materials currently under evaluation are in the areas of:

- Elementary Social Studies (Grades K-5) English and Spanish materials
- Secondary Social Studies (Grades 6-12) Includes the following courses: 6th grade World Cultures, 7th grade Texas History, 8th grade U.S. History to 1877, U.S. History since 1877, World History, World Geography, Government, Economics, Psychology, Sociology
- High School Mathematics (Grades 9-12) Includes the following courses: Algebra I; Algebra 2; Geometry; Mathematical Models with Applications; PreCalculus;
- Fine Arts (Grades K-12) Includes the following: Art, Music, Theatre, Dance, Music

- Studies, Musical Theatre, Technical Theatre
- Career and Technical Education: Principles in Floral Design
