CRITERIA FOR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The purpose of the scholarship awards program is to select those outstanding students who best exemplify the attitudes, skills, personal decorum and overall standing in the student community which the New Jersey Cooperative Education Coordinators Association (N.J.C.E.C.A) represents. Criteria for selection will include the following:

1. All students to be considered must be a 12th grader in 2016 - 2017 and enrolled in a recognized Cooperative Education Program, and graduate in June of 2017.
2. Coordinators who are members of the NJCECA as of December 1, 2016 are eligible to submit applications for student candidates.
3. All applicants are encouraged to take the A.S.V.A.B. test. Please contact your guidance department for scheduling information. Those who have not taken the test will be able to apply, but will not be considered for a scholarship until after test takers have been considered.
4. All student applicants and A.S.V.A.B. results are to be submitted to the Scholarship Chairperson.
5. **Finalists will be required to attend a panel interview before the scholarship committee at Lincoln Tech* for Friday, March 10, 2017 from 9:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. (The snow date is Friday; March 17, 2017)**

In addition, all applicants must submit the following documents, in a folder, at that time.

- A. Two letters of recommendation from his / her school administrators, teachers, or counselors
- B. A letter of recommendation from his / her employer
- C. A student resume
- D. Students applying for an art school scholarship must bring at least three examples of related work, along with the letters
- E. Optional documents (not required): transcripts, awards, etc.

NOTE: To students applying to Berkley College. After taking the ASVAB test, you **MUST** bring a copy of your most recent transcript showing a GPA of 2.5 or higher to the interview session in March. Please give the transcript to Howard Schlesinger, NOT the interviewer. Coordinators can also mail the transcript to Howard Schlesinger prior to the interview if they choose to do so.

6. Scholarship recipients will be notified through their coordinators. Each scholarship winner is required to visit the school sponsoring the scholarship prior to June 2017.

Each school reserves the right to establish fees beyond tuition for books, equipment, etc. It is up to the student to inquire as to the total cost of the school program.
