# New Hospital and Medical Office Building Project Update

Bronson's \$22 million investment to replace our aging hospital and medical office buildings at 955 S. Bailey Ave. with a brand new facility continues to progress on schedule. We are currently proceeding, in partnership with Elzinga & Volkers out of Holland, on the design development phase of the project. We will provide updates on the final facility layout and floor plan when they become available.

Requisite approvals for certificate of need have been submitted to the State of Michigan and we await confirmation.

Our goal remains to break ground in late 2019 and complete construction by December 2020.



#### Bronson South Haven Wound Program Recognized as a Healogics National President's Circle Center of Excellence

Bronson Wound & Hyperbaric Medicine in South Haven has been designated as a President's Circle Center of Excellence for outstanding performance in wound healing. The national award is only given to centers that achieve patient satisfaction rates

higher than 92 percent; a healing rate of a least 91 percent in less than 30 median days; and are able to maintain these high levels of clinical and operational performance over two consecutive years.

While Healogics partners with over 800 hospitals in 46 states, only 28 wound centers are being recognized this year as achieving National President's Circle Center of Excellence status. Bronson Wound & Hyperbaric Medicine in South Haven is the only center in Michigan to receive the designation this year.

## Bronson South Haven Hospital Receives Level IV Trauma Center Status

Bronson South Haven Hospital was recently designated a Level IV Trauma Center by the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS). This three-year designation recognizes the important role Bronson South Haven plays as part of regionalized, coordinated and accountable trauma system in the state of Michigan.

The designation was awarded after an extensive review process and onsite survey. As a Level IV Trauma Center, Bronson South Haven has demonstrated its ability to provide advanced trauma life support (ATLS) prior to transfer of critically ill or injured patients to a higher level trauma center.

According to guidelines established by the American College of Surgeons, a trauma center's ranking is measured based on the facility's commitment, readiness, resources, policies, patient care and performance improvements. Bronson South Haven is proud of this achievement and the skilled staff

who ensure excellence in emergency services at our hospital.

Rita Cox, system trauma program director at Bronson, and Thomas Mikulski, trauma medical director at Bronson South Haven Hospital, were both recognized by MDHHS as assets to the program.

### Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA)

Over the last several months, Bronson has worked with the Community Health Committee of the Human Services Collaborative of Van Buren to collect data for the development of the 2019 Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA). In Van Buren County, 10 focus groups have been conducted and 8 key informant interviews have been held, engaging a total of 223 individuals.

On May 9, a Community Input Session will be held at the Van Buren ISD Conference Center for those who participated in the focus groups and interviews. The top 10 health needs identified from the data collected will be presented and the group will prioritize the top five health needs of Van Buren County. The results of this process will be included in the CHNA report, which is expected to be published in November 2019. Bronson's plan to address these needs as a system will be developed and approved by April 2020.

This project is done in partnership with Van Buren County Community Health Stakeholders, Van Buren County Health Department and Van Buren ISD.
