AMMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING A PRIVATE BURIAL/CEMETERIES PROVISION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Marion Township to amend the Marion Township Zoning Ordinances to add the following provision:

AMMENDMENED AS FOLLOWS:

PRIVATE BURIAL/CEMETERIES—The private burial of the deceased shall be permitted on private property in zoning districts A-1, A-2, C-2 and R-2 within the township by conditional use so long as it is in compliance with all county, state and federal requirements at the time of the burial. All gravesites within a private burial/cemetery shall comply with the designated set back requirements for the district in which the burial takes place. The grave shall include head and corner markers to clearly delineate the location of the grave and the markers shall be permanently maintained. This section shall in no way apply to any organizational or commercial cemetery already defined and regulated by the township.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED as an Amendment to the Marion Township Zoning Ordinance originally enacted June 10, 2008. By action of the Board of Supervisors, this amendment will be enacted this 13th day of October 2009.
