

**VILLAGE OF WOODSBURGH  
LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER  
CURFEW/PROHIBITION OF PRESENCE OF PERSONS ON PUBLIC  
STREETS OR PUBLIC PLACES**

I, LEE ISRAEL, the Mayor of the Village of Woodsburgh, in accordance with and furtherance of a proclamation of State of Emergency in the Village previously executed by me on this date pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, and in the interest of both public safety and the protection of property and residents from damage, injury or danger resulting from the following:

In response to the death of George Floyd, a black man in Minneapolis who died after an officer knelt on his neck, and deaths of other black men and women, protests, demonstrations and marches have been taking place across the United States. Some of these protests, demonstrations and marches have escalated, by some persons, to include actions of assault, vandalism, property damage and/or looting. These acts of violence and damage have occurred primarily during the hours of darkness, and it is especially difficult for the Village to assure and preserve public safety during such hours.

Today, I was made aware of planned demonstrations and/or marches, to take place this evening, where one or more of the organizers has made threats to communities of "white privilege", and that these demonstrations may result in the potential for violence or damage in the Village.

To address this threat, I hereby declare a Village-wide curfew from 7:00pm on June 2, 2020 through 6:00am on June 3, 2020. During this time, no persons or vehicles with any occupants may be in public.

This Order shall not apply to police officers, peace officers, firefighters, first responders, Village retained security, and other essential emergency personnel.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for the period herein provided, unless sooner rescinded, superseded or amended by Order of the Mayor, or as otherwise provided by law. This Order may also be renewed in five day increments or otherwise as provided by law.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law Section 24(5).

LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Village of Woodsburgh ("Village"), Nassau County, New York, effective at 5:00pm on June 2, 2020.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to a reasonable apprehension of immediate danger, with public safety potentially imperiled, on account of threats made by organizers of marches and/or protests seeking retribution or retaliation against Village residents and property, termed by the organizers as "white privilege".

Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of the Village.

The State of Emergency shall be applicable to the entire Village.

This State of Emergency shall remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As Chief Executive of the Village, I have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct all Village departments to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.

ORDER CONTROLLING PRESENCE OF PERSONS ON PUBLIC STREETS AND PLACES

ORDER ESTABLISHING CURFEW


I, [Name], the Chief Executive of the [City/Village/Town] of [name of City/Village/Town] in accordance with a proclamation of State of Emergency executed on the [date] and pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, do hereby declare and order that a curfew is established and imposed.

During the period of such curfew, all pedestrian and vehicular traffic, except essential emergency vehicles and personnel, shall be prohibited from the use of the public streets within this municipality between the hours of [time] and [time].

This order shall take effect [IMMEDIATELY or specify date and time] and shall remain in effect until removed by order of the Chief Executive. This order may also be renewed in [no.]-day increments.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law Section 24(5).

## DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, due to the lack of rain and the extreme drought conditions in the [City/Village/ Town] of [name of City/Village/Town] (hereinafter the “[City/Village/Town]”) there is an increased chance of grass, brush, forest and other similar types of fire; and

**WHEREAS**, the current drought conditions have created an imminent threat of widespread fires resulting in severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from natural or man-made fires, as well as the depletion of public and private water supplies; and

**WHEREAS**, restrictions are necessary on outside open burning, whether supervised or not, except (a) within a self-contained barbecue unit or pit, manufactured or built for the sole purpose of barbecuing food, or (b) fireworks display at a municipal or civic function that is supervised by the municipality or civic organization, in accordance with a plan developed with the local fire district;

**WHEREAS**, the [City/Village/Town] desires to take all necessary steps to impose restrictions on the use of water for public or private water supplies;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it hereby

**ORDERED** that a **STATE OF EMERGENCY** now exists within the [City/Village/Town], and due to the imminent threat of fires as a result of the dry conditions that currently exist within the [City/Village/Town] and that all persons within [City/Village/Town] are hereby:

**I. PROHIBITED** from any outside open burning of any type or nature, whether supervised or unsupervised, except (a) within a self-contained barbecue unit or pit, manufactured or built for the sole purposes of barbecuing food, or (b) fireworks display at a municipal or civic function that is supervised by the municipality or civic organization, in accordance with a plan developed with the local fire district, and it is further

**II. PROHIBITED** from using water from either a public or private water supply in connection with the following activities:


- a) Washing cars by means of a hose.
- b) Washing cars at a car dealership except in preparation for an immediate sale.
- c) Watering of established lawns.
- d) Watering of gardens, flowers, trees, or shrubbery except during the hours of 7 P.M. to Midnight or 5–8 A.M. with a hand-held hose with spray nozzle or a watering can.
- e) Washing of houses, patios, driveways, walkways, etc. unless in preparation for painting.

- f) Automatically serving water to patrons in restaurants.
- g) Watering of athletic fields.
- h) Watering golf courses except for greens, tees, and aprons or ground under repair.

ORDERED, that anyone violating this Order is guilty of a Class B misdemeanor, and subject to a fine to be fixed by the Court not to exceed \$250.00 for the first offense and \$500.00 for any subsequent offenses; and it is further

ORDERED, that this order shall be effective from [date] to [date] unless otherwise extended.
