Directions: From the EAST:

At the light in Schellsburg, continue <u>West on Rt. 30</u>. Look for Rose Road in 1.8 miles. <u>Make a right onto</u> <u>Rose Road</u>. Follow Rose Road for about a mile. <u>Make a right onto</u> <u>Hoover Road</u>. <u>Make the first left onto Winegardner Road</u> (at the white Allegheny Mennonite Church) and go about a mile to the round house on the right. You will be climbing up the mountain.

To get to the picnic pavilion: continue on Winegardner Road past the house and driveway several hundred feet to the row of trees. Make a right just before the row of trees. We will have it marked WOSA. Follow this grassy road down and below the lower alpaca pasture and you will see the pavilion.

From the West (Somerset County):

Turn before you get to Schellsburg, making a Left onto **Rose Road**. Follow Rose Road for about a mile. **Make a right onto Hoover Road**. **Make the first left onto Winegardner Road** (at the white Allegheny Mennonite Church) and go about a mile to the round house on the right. You will be climbing up the mountain. **To get to the picnic pavilion, follow directions above.**
