Greetings Again, Fellow Members of the American Legion Family.

Well, we continue to do well as we finish the first Quarter. In the Clubroom/Building Account we had one small rental and two regular size rentals upstairs and a small one downstairs with above average Bar Tab. Daily Attendance on the average has remained the same.

Friday Night Dinners continue to do well and the bar has been doing much better on Friday nights. The Sons, Riders, and Auxiliary each made \$200.00 donations for the Children's Easter Party. We received \$23.00 from ATM Machine Fees and \$30.00 from coffee donations. Parking Lot Fund has trickled to a stop. Anonymous donor donated \$20.00, Bob Schmidline donated \$100.00, Paul Fortin donated \$50.00, List Reports, N. Parking Lot Rental \$900.00 and that is it.

As of March 31st, we have received \$15,810.00, just a little over our Goal of \$30,000.00. We paid \$24,394.00 to have both sides completely resurfaced, almost depleting our bank account. We still have other repairs that are needed badly. If you can, please contribute to the cause. Just because the lots are completed, it doesn't mean we already had the money for it. It just had to be done.

Donation that have come in in April will be reported next month.

In the Legion Account, 4 members paid their dues, had 2 new members, and had 6 members that paid on line. Thanks to those that have paid your dues. If you haven't paid, please do so. We still have over 50 members that haven't paid. March's Third, Fourth, and Fifth Friday Opportunity Drawings brought in \$295.00 for Bugle support. Thanks to all that come in and support the Friday Night Opportunity Drawings.

On March 10th we had a Boys State Fundraiser Dance. We did well, well enough that we now have enough money to send 4 boys to Boys State. Besides the \$877.00 door profit from ticket sales and small donations, we received \$500.00 from the Riders, \$250.00 from the Sons, and \$200.00 from Rufino & Maria Solis-Martinez, a generous couple, Members from American Legion Post 72 in Anaheim. Our 2nd Vice, Ways & Means Chairman Bill Stringfield threw in the \$101.20 Donation from Katella Grill to make it a grand total of \$1928.20. Thanks to all that helped out. 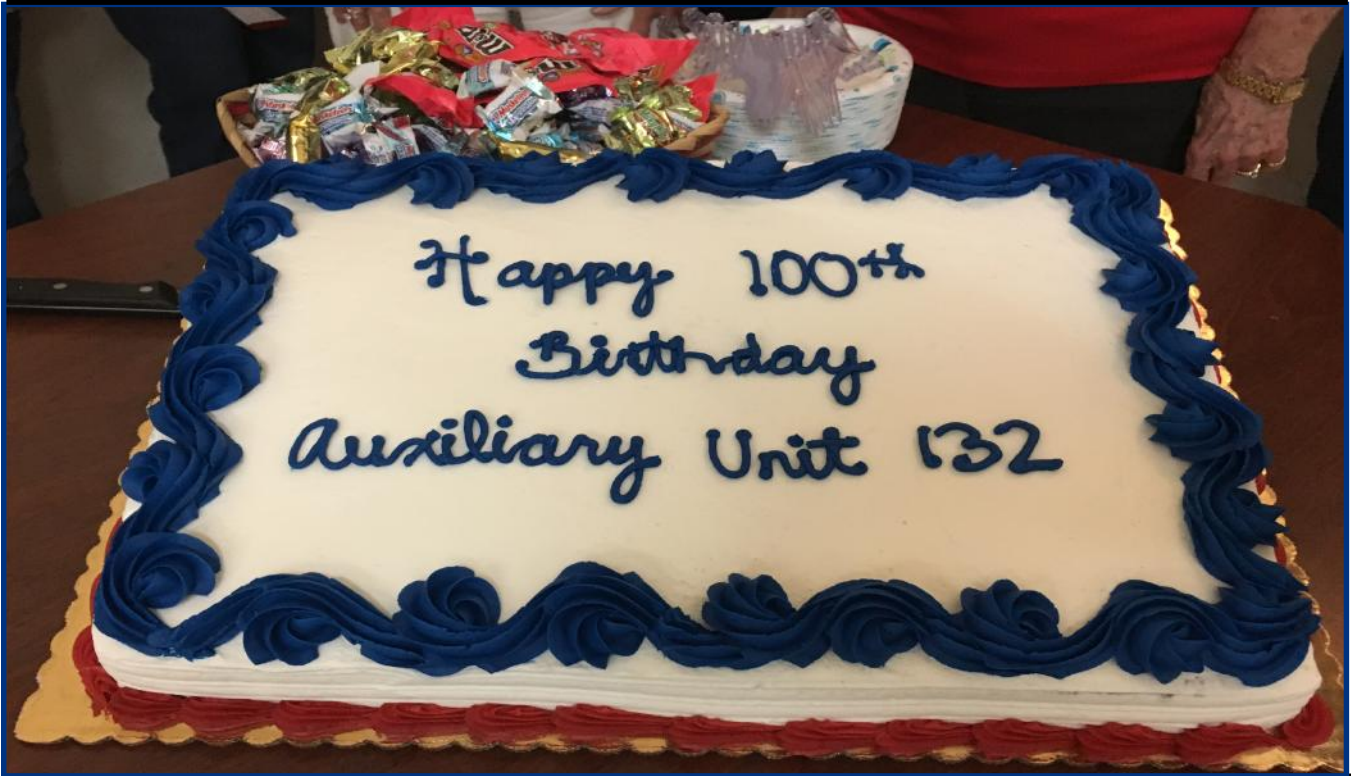
