

## **Making People Thirsty -1.**

It has been often said that you can bring a horse to water, but you can't make him drink. Does this mean that you can't witness to a person who doesn't want to hear it? The Next several lesson we will learn how to make people thirsty for Christ.

### **1. Confessing Christ Determines Your Salvation:**

Mt 10:32 Whosoever therefore shall \_\_\_\_\_  
me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.

But whosoever shall \_\_\_\_\_ before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.

Lu 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also \_\_\_\_\_ before the angels of God:

9 But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.

### **2. Confession of Christ and Salvation:**

Ro 10:9 9 That if thou shalt \_\_\_\_\_ with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

10 For with the heart man \_\_\_\_\_ unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

Ro. 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

### **3. Responsibility to Preach Christ:**

Ro. 10:15 And how shall they \_\_\_\_\_, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace,

and bring glad tidings of good things!

#### **4. Faith Comes by Hearing the Word of God:**

Ro 10:17 So then \_\_\_\_\_ *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Ro 9:33 As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

#### **5. Many People are Ready for Harvest – to be Gathered in:**

Jo 4: 35 Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white\_\_\_\_to harvest.

#### **6. Like Philip we must Opened our mouth & speak of Jesus:**

Ac 8:26¶ And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert.

Ac 8:29 Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.

Ac 8:30 And Philip ran thither to *him*, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest?

Ac 8:31 And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him.

Ac 8:34 And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man?

Ac 8:35 Then Philip \_\_\_\_\_, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.

Ac 8:37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I

## **7. Confess Your Personal Experience with Jesus:**

1Jo 1:3 That which we have \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship *is* with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

1Jo. 1:3-3.

## **Conversion Demonstrates a Before and an After**

The Demoniac is an example of a Before and After encounter with Jesus.  
Mark 5.

### **His Life Before Receiving Eternal Life:**

#### **8. Extent of His man's condition - He was demon possessed:**

Mark 5:1 And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.

2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an \_\_\_\_\_,

#### **9. Untamable and an association with death:**

Mark 1:3 Who had *his* dwelling among the tombs; and no man could \_\_\_\_\_ him, no, not with chains:

4 Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any *man tame* him.

#### **10. He had Insomnia- restless – could not sleep:**

Mark 1:5 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains,

11. **Hysteria – Constant Crying:**  
and in the tombs, \_\_\_\_\_,
12. **Self-mutualization – Hurting himself:**  
and \_\_\_\_\_ himself with stones.
13. **But He Desired Deliverance:**  
Mark 5:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and \_\_\_\_\_ him,
14. **But the Demons tried to hold onto him:**  
Mark 5:7 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.
15. **Jesus Commanded the Demon to Leave:**  
Mark 5:8 For he said unto him, Come \_\_\_\_\_ of the man, *thou* unclean spirit.
16. **Possessed with many demons:**  
Mark 1:9 And he asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, My name is \_\_\_\_\_: for we are \_\_\_\_\_.  
10 And he besought him much that he would not send them away out of the country.  
11 Now there was there nigh unto the mountains a great herd of swine feeding.  
12 And all the devils besought him, saying, Send us into the swine, that we may enter into them.  
13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in the sea.  
14 And they that fed the swine fled, and told it in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.
17. **Jesus Healed Him:**  
Mark 1:15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his \_\_\_\_\_ mind: and they were afraid.

**18. Others Saw the Difference:**

Mark 1:16 And they that saw *it* told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil, and *also* concerning the swine.

**19. Go Home to thy Friends:**

Mark 5:18 And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed him that he might be with him.

19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go \_\_\_\_\_ to thy \_\_\_\_\_, and tell them how great things the Lord hath \_\_\_\_\_ for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.

**20. He proclaimed the great things Jesus did for Him:**

Mark 5:20 And he departed, and began to \_\_\_\_\_ in Decapolis how \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus had done for him: and all *men* did marvel.

Luke 8:38 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ him away, saying,

**21. We are to Go to our Family:**

Luke 8:39 Return to thine own \_\_\_\_\_, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the \_\_\_\_\_ how \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus had done unto him.

**22. See the Result of Christ's influence in one man's life:**

**23. Tell Specifically what has God done for your Soul:**

Ps 66:16 Come *and* hear, all ye that fear God, and I will declare what he hath \_\_\_\_\_ for my soul.

### **24. Before Eternal Life we are afraid of death.**

Heb 2:15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

### **25. Facing the Judgment:**

Heb 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the \_\_\_\_\_:

1Ti 5:24 Some men's sins are open beforehand, going before to \_\_\_\_\_; and some *men* they follow after.

Ro 1:32 Who knowing the \_\_\_\_\_ of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

Ro 2:2 But we are sure that the \_\_\_\_\_ of God is according to truth against them which commit such things.

What has your life have been like after eternal life.

### **27. No longer afraid of Death.**

Heb 2:15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

### **28. You have the certainty of eternal life.**

He that hath the Son hath \_\_\_\_\_; *and* he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. 1 Jn 5: 11-13.

### **29. You are not alone.**

Heb 13:5 *Let your conversation be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never \_\_\_\_\_ thee, nor forsake thee.

### **30. Fruit of the Spirit.**

Ga 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

### **31. You have peace**

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, \_\_\_\_\_ I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Ps 119:165 Great \_\_\_\_\_ have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

### **32. You have direction.**

Ps 32:8 I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.

### **33. You have a Future.**

Jer 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

### 34. You Live by Faith:

Ro 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Ga 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

### 35. You have Hope.

Tit 1:2 In hope of \_\_\_\_\_ life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

Tit 3:7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of \_\_\_\_\_ life.

# Paul's Personal -- Experience of Salvation

## I. His Life Before Eternal Life:

### 1. He was raised Religiously Strict:

Ac. 26:4 My manner of life from my youth, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, know all the Jews;

5 Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

### 2. Before He was against Christ:

Ac. 26:9 I verily thought with myself, that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

### 3. Before Christ He persecuted the Church:

Ac. 26:10 Which thing I also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against them.

Ac. 26:11 And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled them to blaspheme; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted them even unto strange cities.

## II. Paul's Life when He Met Christ on the Damascus Road

### 4. Paul intended to Persecute:

Ac. 26:12 Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,

### 5. Paul saw the Light:

Ac. 26:13 At midday, O king, I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me.

In him was life; and the life was the light of men. Jn 1:4.

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. Joh 8:12

### 6. Paul was convicted by the light:

Ac. 26:14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking

unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? *it is* hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

## **7. Holy Spirit Convicts us of Sin, righteousness and Judgment to come:**

Joh 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly. Jn 4:18.

## **8. Paul met the Savior:**

Ac. 26:15 And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.

The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things.

Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am *he*. Jn 4: 25, 26.

## **The Moment you meet the Savior you realize that you are Wrong and He is right.**

## **9. Paul Submits to Christ:**

And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord *said* unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do. Acts 9:6.

### **III. Paul’s Life After receiving Eternal Life:**

#### **10. From Persecutor to Preacher:**

Ac. 26:16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;

#### **11. From Captor to liberator:**

Ac. 26:17 Delivering thee from the people, and *from* the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,

- 12. From darkness to Leading others to the Light:**  
Ac. 26:18 To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- 13. From Disobedient to Obedient:**  
Ac. 26:19 Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision:
- 14. From an Exclusive Self-Righteous Pharisee to Evangelist**  
Ac. 26:20 But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.
- 15. From Murderer to Martyr:**  
Ac. 26:21 For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill me.
