



Engineered Wood Flooring VS Solid Hardwood Flooring

- *Engineered Wood Flooring is made of real wood, but includes multiple layers with the top layer being made of a high quality wood.
- *Engineered Wood Flooring can be installed at, above, or below grade.
- *Engineered Wood Flooring can be installed by gluing, nailing or stapling, or installed as a floating floor.
- *Most Engineered Wood Floors are prefinished from the manufacturer.
- *Engineered Wood Flooring is between 3/8" and 1/2" in height.



- *Solid Wood Flooring is made of one piece of wood from top to bottom.
- *Solid Wood Flooring can be installed on any level at or above grade.
- *Solid Wood Flooring is typically installed over a plywood underlayment.
- *Solid Wood Flooring is installed by nailing or stapling.
- *Solid Wood Flooring can be refinished multiple times.
- *Solid Wood Flooring has an authentic, timeless, durability.
