Financial Update: download October's financial update <u>HERE</u>. October income showed a surplus of \$7,567, leaving Eastside in good shape for the year. The year-to-date surplus is \$7,010 and the bank balance (counting the Whitmore Park reserve) is \$50,905. PAR giving was flat to September, and the LSC account maintains a healthy balance of \$35,868. This is also an end of the year reminder to get donations in for the end of the tax season!
