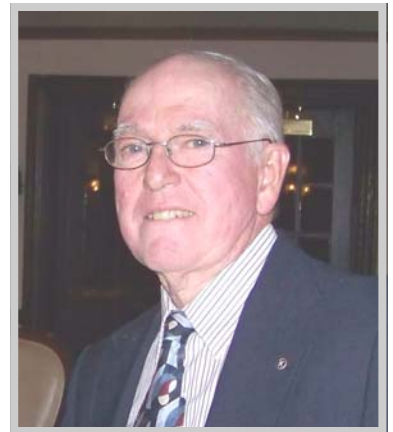

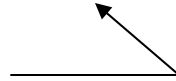

ALVERNIA SHOW, AUG 3

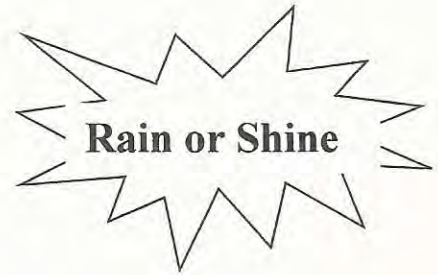
