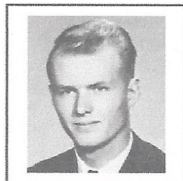

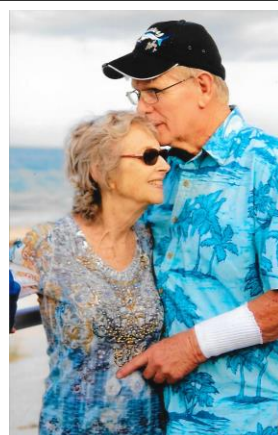
To Those I Love & Those Who Love Me
