

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2016-52**

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING DARREN DICKENS HOURLY RATE AS A POLICE OFFICER FOR AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor of Amelia Village, after conferring with the Police Chief, has recommended that after the completion of the probationary period of Darren Dickens as a full time police officer for Amelia Village, that he receive an hourly pay increase; and

**WHEREAS**, The Council of Amelia Village concurs that Darren Dickens should receive an hourly wage increase for his work as a full time Amelia Village police officer.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

**SECTION I.** Darren Dickens who is employed as a full time police officer of Amelia Village and has completed the required probationary period, will receive an increase of salary to \$17.54 per hour effective December 12, 2016.

**SECTION II.** Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is to ensure timely payment to Officer Darren Dickens who has completed his required probationary period. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

MR. FITE seconded the motion.


