C. ACKNOWLEDGMENT/NOTARIALS/AUTHENTICATION, REPORTS OF BIRTH/MARRIAGE/DEATH, NBI

- No need to book an appointment.
- Applicants must submit a prepaid return envelope (Xpresspost) for the release of their documents.
- Xpresspost envelope is not required for NBI applicants.
