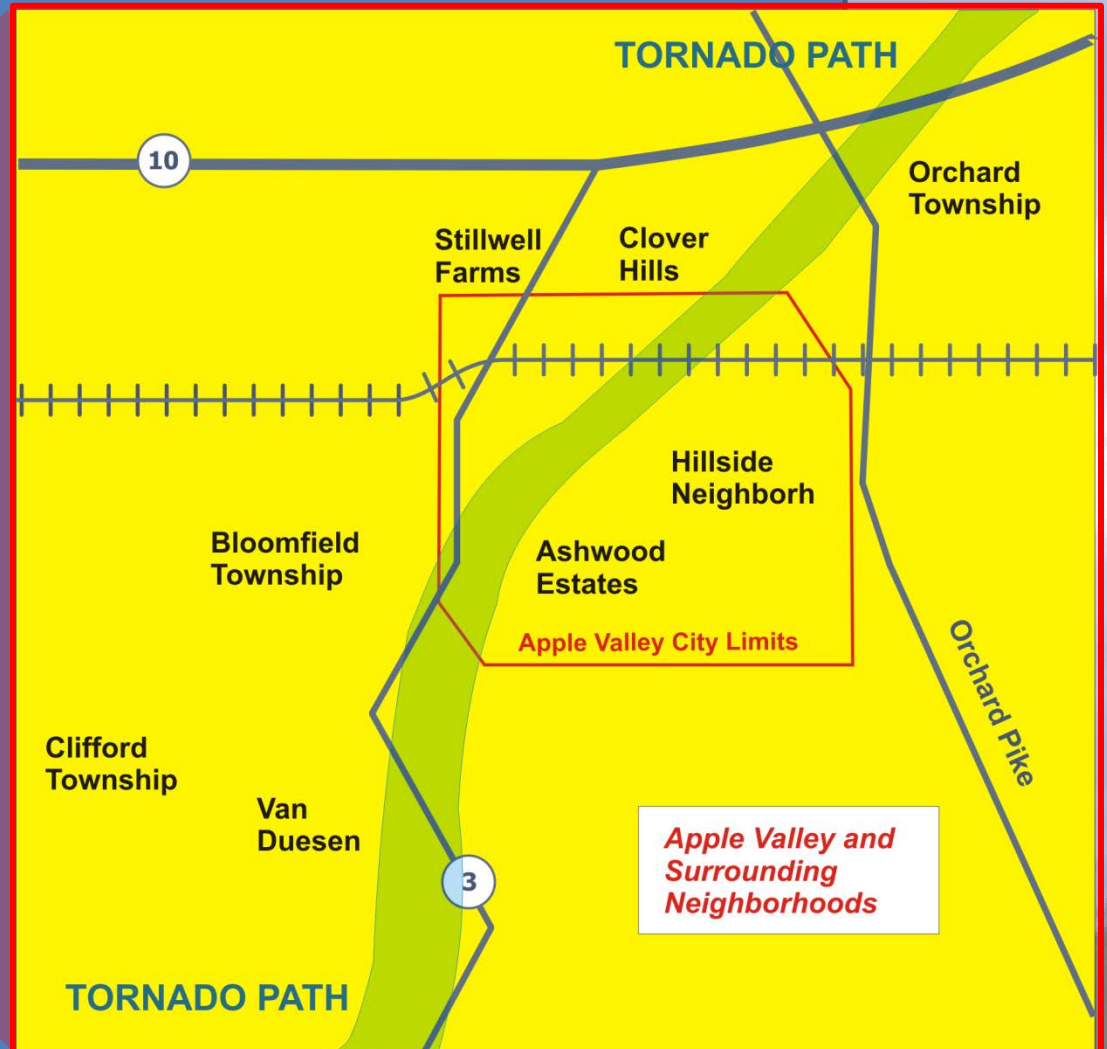
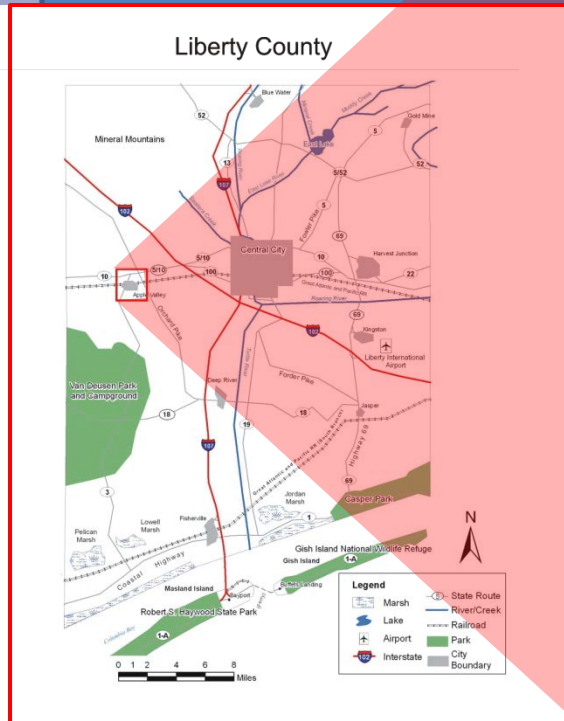


The tornado also struck the John Chapman Fairgrounds is located on SR 3 just south of Apple Valley. In continuous operation since 1887, the fairgrounds houses an outdoor stage, exhibit rinks, and indoor displays as well as food tents and animal exhibits. There was a horse show in progress and patrons received little or no warning on the tornado. Several animals have been killed.

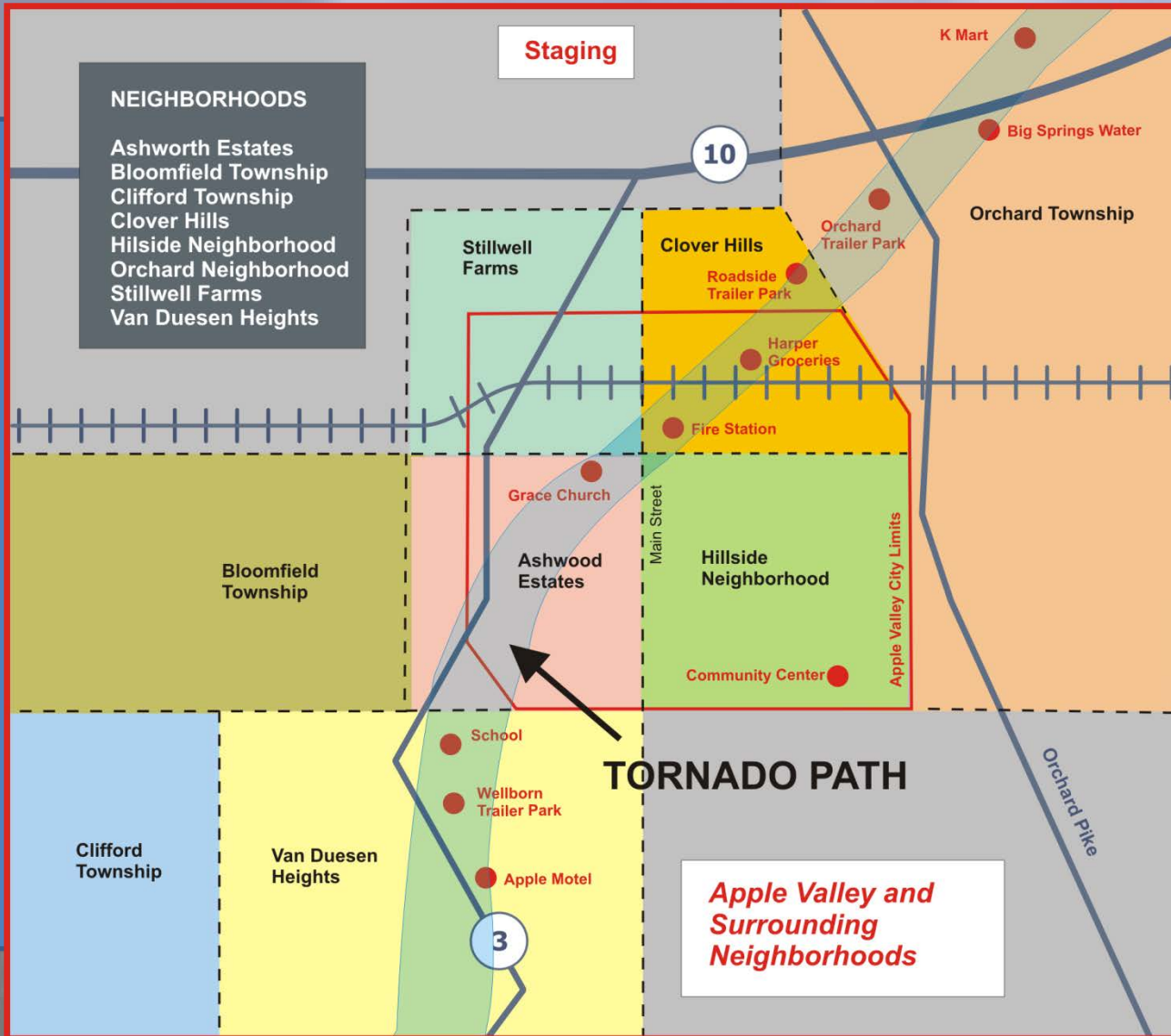
