New DVDs

Several new DVDs have been released and are now available on the PJA website. They include:

1. Shingin No Maki

Professor Bob McKean demonstrates the 38 arts of Shingin No Maki as they were taught to him and Professor Bob Krull by Professor Bill Montero. An additional 10 arts from other DZR sources have been included in the DVD. This DVD is only available to DZR black belts.

2. 250 Photos – Professor Okazaki and the Early Years of DZR.

This is a slide show of historic DZR photos with traditional Japanese background music.

3. Professor Francis Merlin "Bud" Estes (1909 – 1981).

Professor Estes demonstrating and teaching Yawara, Nage No Kata, Shime No Kata, Oku No Kata and Shinin No Maki at the 1st AJJF Black Belt Convention, 1977.

4. Professor Bob Krull (1936 – 2004)

Professor Krull teaches and demonstrates a series of Olympic Judo warm-up exercises, 1987.

5. Professor Pat Browne (1947 – 1996)

Professor Browne demonstrates 92 arts and variations of Danzan Ryu Jujitsu. The 92 arts are played at normal speed and then at a slower speed. Traditional Japanese music has been added to the background.
