Lessons from a Virginia Tech Survivor

Sex Offender Registration in Illinois

This session will provide information to the participants on the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act (730 ILCS 150) and Illinois Murderer & Violent Offender Against Youth Registration Act (730 ILCS 154) as the laws pertain to those adjudicated as juvenile delinquents. This session will provide valuable information regarding all laws pertaining to juvenile registrants in Illinois.

Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events

Active shooter events have continued to occur in the workplace, malls, churches, schools, and communities across the country and the world. Probation and Court Services Departments are certainly not exempt from this type of events occurring. Any one of us has the potential to gain entry into a club that no one ever wants to be in—whether it be at work or in our personal lives. Therefore, the training is designed to provide strategy and ways to help survive an active assailant event.

Human Trafficking/Child Abduction

Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking:

Agents will introduce partners to Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking as a local, state, and national issue. Participants will be advised on trafficking to include victimology, methods and psychology of victimization, local and national trends, and investigative strategies via recent and historical case studies. Agents will advise on recent and historical investigations highlighting federal and state Cooperation for the benefit of trafficking victims and the recovery of victimized children.

Child Abduction:

Agents will introduce partners to recent cases, both local and national. Partners will be advised regarding stranger abduction vs. familial abduction, false claims, abduction immediate response, best practices, and command post considerations via recent and historical case studies. Agents will advise on current efforts between local and federal authorities to join efforts in bringing about effective investigations and the recovery of child victims.

Law Enforcement participants will be provided with additional materials produced by the FBI as a continuation of their education on both fronts.

Legal Updates

This Juvenile Law Update will include the recent amendments to the juvenile records provisions, developments in juvenile procedure, stalking and orders of protection, firearms restraining orders, sex offenses and offenders, truancy, search and seizure, confessions, and any relevant cases from the United States Supreme Court in 2019.
