

Maurice J. Mousseau Born: November 26, 1926

Maurice J. Mousseau, age 88, resident of Kinde, passed away on March 31, 2015 at Huron Medical Center.

He was born November 26, 1926 in Kinde to the late Nelson E. and Arla M. (Chapdelaine) Mousseau.

Maurice and Delores V. Krinkie were united in marriage on May 8, 1948 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Dwight Township. She preceded him in death on July 18, 2009. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, Dwight Township and also St. Edward's Catholic Church, Kinde. He served in the U.S. Maritime Service and Merchant Marines during WWII in the Pacific Theater. Maurice was employed by the Huron Co. Road Commission for 42 years as a weight master and construction supervisor. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus for 52 years joining the First Degree on November 29, 1962, the 2nd and 3rd Degree on March 24, 1963 and the 4th Degree on April 1, 1964. He held the positions of Grand Knight, District Deputy of the Knights of the Thumb Area, District Marshal, Past Navigator of the Fourth Degree Bishop Babcok General Assembly #0487 and served as the Color Corp Commander for 30 years. Maurice was a member of the Port Austin Frank Horetski American Legion Post #499 and the Caseville F.O.E. #3690.

He was an avid sportsman and a member of the Grindstone Sportmen's Club, and a charter boat captain for 15 years. He loved playing the guitar. Maurice was an honorary member of the Ubly Fox Hunters Club. He was also involved in the Steelheaders, served on the Kinde Village Council, North Huron Board of Education for 6 years, Kinde Fire Department for 35 years and retired as Rescue Captain. He also served on the Kinde Fire Department Board. He was a member for many years of the Caseville Golf Course.
