1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Comerford at 11:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance and roll call were administered.

3. Vote: Resolution: 2017-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER INLET COLONY, FLORIDA, REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT ON ALL STREETS IN THE TOWN TO FIFTEEN (15) MILES PER HOUR FOR THE DURATION OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD REHABILITATION PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO (2) ADDITIONAL STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF COLONY ROAD AND LIGHTHOUSE DRIVE THEREBY PROVIDING FOR A THREE-WAY STOP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Discussion: Tom Jensen talked about how the new stop signs will be placed. The resolution makes the speed limit reduction temporary during the construction. The stop signs are worded as being permanently installed. The Commission agreed to further discuss the new stop signs toward the end of the NRP Project. Vice-Mayor DiSarno stated that he believes all driveways should be restored as is but areas where concrete fills the entire right-of-way should be removed. The Commission said they would further discuss this issue at a future meeting.

4. Discussion: Driveway Apron Replacement

Commissioner Legerton talked to the Commission regarding Town right-of-ways. He talked about a few lots where driveway total widths greatly exceed current ordinance restrictions of 24’ total at the roadway. The Commission discussed driveway aprons and the right-of-way.
