# Landmark Gets a 'NAME CHANGE'


'Promise Regional Medical Center of Kansas'
Hutchinson Hospital changes it's Name & it's Image.
They are adding on a 'Trauma Ctr. & Adding to already well known Cardiac Unit. With the addition of the Trauma Unit Hutch will become a Level 3 in service of the more severe injuries and was felt that they needed a name to reflect a Regional Center rather than a community type hospital. It has not been sold nor have there been any desires to follow that pathway.
The name change became effective on Sep. 2, 2008 with a big list of events to get every ones attention.
