



FAQs for Vendors

How big is the property?

Over Three Acres

How many people can Marker 137 accommodate?

Approximately 250

Do I need to provide insurance information?

Yes. Marker 137 is completely insured, both residentially and commercially. However, every vendor must provide proof of liability insurance prior to an event. Each customer will also secure a one-day event liability policy.

Is parking allowed on the property?

Yes, vendor parking is extremely limited and will need to be arranged with the Marker 137 staff prior to the event.

As a vendor where do I load and unload my equipment?

This location is on the North side of the property only.

With whom do I coordinate pre-event site visits as well as delivery and pick up times?

Are there restrictions on when vendors set up and tear down, prior to and after the event?

Yes, generally the set up is the day before the event between 11am and 4pm. Tear down occurs the day after the event between 9am and 12 noon. Marker 137 will work with you on any special requirements beyond these hours.

Does the venue have a commercial kitchen or food staging area available for use?

Is there a dedicated power source for vendors?

Yes, there is a dedicated service pole for most electrical needs.

Is there access to an outside water source?

Yes, cold water only.

Where can the vendor and his/her employees have access to restrooms?

The employees can access the portable restrooms.

Does Marker 137 have exclusive arrangements with specific vendors?
