Wow, what a year it has been! In last year I have "lived" in three different countries, worked as a librarian, paid off my student loans, and visited all the friends and family I could! These things would not be possible without all of you, your prayers, and your financial support. Thank you, thank you, thank you for walking on this journey with me!

In September, I will be returning to Brisbane, Australia to continue helping Youth with a Mission run their ministry. While I am there, I will be staffing two training courses, as well as helping with the logistical running of the base. I will serve for 20 months and some of the activities I will be helping with are:

- •Co-leading small groups of new students
- •Leading two 8 week outreaches (during my DTS I went to Malaysia, but I could go anywhere in southeast Asia, Europe, or Australia)
- •Mentoring students during their time on Base
- •Serve the Brisbane area through adopt a park, blessing ministries, and speaking in schools.

In order for me to be able to do these things, I need your help. To me, this is an unpaid job so to speak, but for you, this means an opportunity to spread the Good News on a global level. I need your help to reach my support goal of \$500 USD a month. This includes meals, rent, and transportation for ministry. Would you consider partnering with me on a monthly basis for this journey? Would you also lift me up in prayer over the next two years? Having an idea what will be coming my way has shown me that's what ahead is not going to be a walk in the park, but a spiritual battle.
