Instructions for Parade Line Up:

FLOATS: 100 block of South Capitol on West side of the Masonic Temple.
HISTORICAL VEHICLES: 100 block of North Capitol on West side of the Masonic Temple.
ROUND-UP CLUBS: West side of Guthrie Junior High on Maple St. between Oklahoma Ave. and Harrison Ave.
MARCHING UNITS: Oklahoma Avenue by Guthrie Junior High Gym
BANDS: 100 block of both Maple St. and Walnut St.
(Band busses park in the 100 block of Maple St. and Walnut St.)

The above locations are all in the same general area.

Directions from 1-35:

Traveling North to Guthrie: Take the Second Guthrie Exit (#157), and go West on Hwy 33 (Noble Ave.) to designated location.

Traveling South to Guthrie: Take the First Guthrie Exit (#157), and go West on Hwy 33 (Noble Ave.) to designated location.

NO CANDY OR OTHER OBJECTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE THROWN FROM FLOATS OR OTHER PARADE ENTRIES.
