Local Leader is Remembered

Sylvia Matousek, a respected labor leader and member of the RC 7 Executive Board, passed away on March 8, 2019 after a long struggle with cancer. A native of Ballston Spa, she watched factory workers struggle for a living wage as a child, establishing her beliefs that made her a formidable unionist.

After graduating from SUNY Oswego, Sylvia began her teaching career with the North Syracuse Central School District. She soon became the President of the North Syracuse Education Association (NSEA), where she served for 37 years. She led a teacher strike in1976 and served, along with five other leaders of NSEA, a ten-day sentence in Jamesville Penitentiary.

Sylvia was the recipient of many local county, state and national awards, including NYSUT's Not For Ourselves Alone and AFT's Living legacy Award.

In retirement, Sylvia continued to work for teachers and educational professionals through her leadership in RC 7, served as a Chairperson of the Dewitt Democratic Party, and received the Onondaga County Democrat of the Year award in 2014. Sylvia not only blessed the lives of her family, husband Vincent Ciccarino and Kathy, Suzanne, and Anthony and their children, but she blessed the lives of all of us – her union family. There are countless numbers of us who were inspired and counseled by Sylvia – and we will miss her quick wit and her straightforward opinions! Sylvia, please continue to watch over us and send us signs when you think we need a little shaking up! We will love you and treasure your memory forever.

Retired teachers have lost their COLAs in the southwest, have had their defined pension plans switched to defined contribution funds, and their health plans have been changed without notice. Whether the cuts and attacks are on pensions, Social Security or health care benefits, they can a take a toll on the type of retirement we had planned for ourselves. You can no longer expect to be *grandfathered*. You have to speak up and show up to oppose anti - retiree efforts, because *grandfather* will most likely not be around to protect you.
