WITHOUT A SCALE

Knowing is important, not just for feeding, but also for medications, dewormer, and general health tracking. Don't happen to own a horse-sized scale? Here's the easy way!





(HEARTGIRTH X HEARTGIRTH X BODY LENGTH) / 330° = WEIGHT OF HORSE

*MATURE: 330 lbs.

*YEARLING: 301 lbs

WEANLING: 280 lbs.

*PONY: 299 lbs.

LENGTH
Measure from
point of shoulder,
straight along the
side, to the point
of horse's rear; as
shown (requires
two people).

STEP Start at the
Start at the highest part of the withers (keeping tape as close behind the elbows as possible), measure circumference.

DO THE MATH
Plug numbers
into the weight
formula (above)
and voilà! Don't
forget to plug the
Heartgirth in
twice.
