AFC Championship Game: Cincinnati at Kansas City.
3:05pm ET on CBS.

1★ KANSAS CITY (-7). KANSAS CITY 32 Cincinnati 23. Cincinnati is making their first AFC Championship appearance since the 1988 season while Kansas City is hosting the AFC Championship for a 4th straight year (NFL-record). KC head coach Andy Reid also coached in 4 straight AFC Championships back in his Philadelphia days so a massive experience edge for the Chiefs here. The Bengals come in off the upset win over the Titans last week on the final play (52-yard FG). It was Cincinnati's first road playoff win in franchise history. The Bengals have now covered 6 straight games and remarkably have only turned the ball over one time in that stretch! The win came despite the fact they were out-gained in their 2nd straight playoff game as QB Joe Burrow was sacked 9 times (tied the record). Cincy also benefited from three Ryan Tannehill interceptions including the last one in the final seconds that set up Cincy's game-winning FG. The Bengals do have an extra day to prep here and played the early game last Saturday. That's compared to Kansas City playing the late game last Sunday. The Buffalo/Kansas City game was simply one of the best games in NFL history as the Chiefs escaped in OT 42-36. The two teams combined for 25 points in the final 1:54! QB Patrick Mahomes moved to 8-0 SU in playoff games when Tom Brady isn't on the opposing sideline. The Chiefs became only the 2nd team in NFL playoff history to top 40-points in back-to-back games. They also notched 552 yards against the No. 1 defense in the NFL. Quite simply, the Chiefs' offense is on another level than the rest of the NFL. Cincinnati did get a 34-31 comeback win over Kansas City on January 2nd so the Bengals will be confident. It is worth noting that since November 1st, that is the only loss for KC (11-1 SU/8-4 ATS). Totals' players note a lot of money has come in on the OVER this week. Remarkably, the Westgate SuperBook in Las Vegas opened this total at 50.5! Safe to say, it didn't last long. KC has seen their games go OVER the total in 7 straight. We lean with the playoff experience edge here for the Chiefs. Also despite winning two playoff games, we haven't been overwhelmed by Cincinnati's play.

NFC Championship Game: San Francisco at L.A. Rams.
6:40pm ET on FOX.

1★ San Francisco (+3.5). L.A. RAMS 24 San Francisco 23. These two division rivals meet for a third time this year. San Francisco has owned the Rams as of late winning six straight including 27-24 in OT on January 9th. In that game, the 49ers over-came a 17-0 halftime deficit. San Francisco did have a 449-265 yard edge. Hard to believe now, but if the 49ers don't make that come-back in Week 18, they would've been sitting at home for the playoffs. Last week the 49ers shocked many by beating the No. 1 seed Green Bay in Lambeau as 6-point underdogs. If you would have told us that San Francisco would win that game without scoring an offensive TD and after Green Bay marched down the field on the opening drive to take a 7-0 lead, we would have given you 100/1 odds. Special teams made a huge difference for the 49ers including a punt-block return for a TD in the 4Q. Meanwhile, the Rams nearly blew a 27-3 lead vs Tampa Bay last week. Four TO's nearly cost them but QB Matthew Stafford and WR Cooper Kupp bailed out head coach Sean McVay with a beautiful pass and catch that set up the game-winning FG on the final play. This is not a good spot for the 49ers. They are playing their 4th straight road game and each of the previous three games were decided on the final play of the game. With that being said, they do have one day extra rest here and if you watched the earlier game between these two at SoFi Stadium, you would have noticed that 49ers' fans made up half the crowd. San Francisco has been the underdog to L.A. in each of the last four meetings and have won each game outright. That's not an outlier. That screams the 49ers have a match-up edge over the Rams that the market is not pricing properly. Yes, the 49ers are the underdog but they've played about as well as anyone down the stretch with a 9-2 SU/ATS mark their last 11 games. Don't fall into the "it's hard to beat a team three times in the same season" trap. It's happened 22 times prior. The team that won the first two has gone 14-8 SU. Per Dr. Bob, the team that is 2-0 in the season series has gone 8-3 ATS in Game 3 when not catching 6 or more points.
