# EXPLANATION OF TRAINING ACTIVITIES

**AKC OBEDIENCE** - Loose lead walking versus heeling with full eye contact. Reliable sits and down stays. Other core commands such as fronts/come and finishes. All of these are essential to anyone who wants to compete in obedience or just for better all-around control of your dog.

**AKC SCENT WORK** - This is a sport that mimics the tasks of working detection dogs to locate a scent and communicate to the handler that the scent has been found. Real-life detection dogs are trained to search for a variety of things: drugs, explosives, human remains, currency, other contraband, living humans (such as for Search and Rescue), and much more. AKC Scent Work takes this amazing working relationship and turns it into a fun game that any dog can play.



There will be a demonstration followed by a participation time with any dogs and handlers who would like to try this sport out for fun.

**AKC TRICK DOG** - How to get started



I will cover all the basics for getting the 4 Trick Dog titles offered by AKC. There will be a working part of this class where you and your dog can learn some very cool tricks even if you don't want the title. Tricks will range from roll over, play a piano, jump through a hoop, beg, crawl, push a skate board and more. This is such a fun class that everyone should attend!

Following the class will be a disc dog demonstration. See Baily, Thor and Reese demonstrate their amazing disc dog skills catching frisbees in the air off my back and chest.

Watch them put their tricks to uses in a fun routine incorporating disc catching.
