2015 Grand Marshals



Donnie and Sally Davidson

Donnie and Sally Davidson are the Grand Marshals of the 2015 Holden Street Fair. The Davidson family has roots dating back over 180 years in the Holden community. Donnie and Sally have been married 35 years and are members of the Holden United Methodist Church. They have been blessed with three children, all of whom were raised on the farm and are graduates of Holden High School.

Donnie, Holden High School class of '67, grew up north of Holden on his family's dairy

farm. Donnie bought out his Uncle Floyd's interest in cows and machinery upon returning from his four-year service in the Navy as a hull technician, second-class, in 1974. He then entered into a partnership with his dad that lasted 12 years until Marshall retired in 1985. Donnie spent over 40 years milking Holstein cows as a business, in addition to the years spent milking as a child helping out on the farm. He sold his dairy cows in November 2013. This ended the 80-year history of the Davidsons selling Grade A milk. He continues to stay busy as the fifth generation farmer to carry on the Homesteaded Family Century Farm with his beef herd and row crops. Donnie has been past president of Johnson County Farm Bureau and served many years as the secretary/treasurer of the Johnson County Dairy Herd Improvement Association. He is President of the Rock Springs Cemetery Association (where 3 generations of Davidsons are buried), member of the Johnson County Watershed District Board and has managed a team in the West Central BCA pool league out of the Cowboy Inn for 25 years.

Sally, 'MOOses Davidson', Merritt Island High class of '70, grew up mostly in Florida. After 28 years of teaching, 22 of which were at Holden Elementary (nine and a half years off in the middle to stay home and raise their three children), Sally (University of Central Florida, BS-1973, M.Ed.-1974; University of Central Missouri, Specialist-1979) retired in 2011 so she could stay home again and this time watch their GRAND children. She taught a 'Dairy Good' themed 'MOO MOO Herd' Kindergarten during her last 19 years of teaching. While teaching, she received several awards including HTA Teacher of the Year & MSTA Central Region Outstanding Elementary Educator. She developed and coordinated a Holden Elementary School geography program for ten years (Where in the World Is the Holden Eaglet?) and also developed and coordinated a Holden districtwide Top Two Academic Award Recognition Program for 13 years. Sally volunteered six years to coach the Carebears T-ball team, having practices at the ball field in her yard, and co-coached the Daredevils and Doves softball teams. She has served as past President of: West Central Missouri International Reading Association; Mu Chapter - Delta Kappa Gamma (Honorary Women's Educator's Society); Holden PTA and Kappa Nu-Beta Sigma Phi. Sally is still active with Delta Kappa Gamma, Holden Community Praise and Glory Handbell Choir, Holden R-3 School Foundation Board and is very involved in her church activities and choir. Sally was a graduate of the 1st Johnson County Master Gardener's class and was awarded the Johnson County Farm Bureau, Farm Wives' Hall of

Over the past 35 years, Donnie has rearranged his schedule to host hundreds of children and their families (MOO MOO Kindergarten Herds, 4-H Clubs, church groups, home schoolers, Warrensburg C.L.I.M.B., Farm Bureau and their own children's parties) on their farm for dairy tours, hayrides, bonfires and picnics. In their early years of marriage, they were members of the Holden Tennis Club and danced in the Holden-Ons Square Dance Club. Donnie and Sally were selected as the 1993 Johnson County Farm Bureau Farm Family.

Donnie and Sally have also taken time to raise a family on the farm. Their oldest son, Dusty and his wife, Celia, both live and work in Holden. Dusty is an agricultural loan officer for Central Bank of Warrensburg and Celia teaches and coaches at Holden High School. They have two sons, Kyler (4) and Colby (2). Their younger son, Rocky, has a degree in computer engineering technology and is a software engineer for Garmin in Munich, Germany. Their daughter, Sandy McKeown, lives in Moberly with her husband, Chuck. Sandy coaches cross country and is a math teacher at Moberly High School and Chuck is the broker of the Century 21 Real Estate business in Moberly. They are expecting their first child, a son, in October.

Donnie and Sally are both honored and excited to serve as Grand Marshals of the 2015 Holden Street Fair. They have both dedicated their lives to service and are proud members of the Holden community.

Three dimensional work requiring special pedestal or set-up will be the responsibility of the artist. Failure to comply with specifications may result in disqualification of entry.

Although all due precautions will be taken in handling artwork, The Chamber of Commerce and Community Activity Center are not responsible for any loss or damage to artwork. Any insurance coverage must be provided by the artist. The Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to photograph accepted entries for use in promotional materials.

Prizes: Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. One "Best of Show Fran Stumpff Memorial Award" will be awarded. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, as well as best in show will be awarded in each category. In the event there is only one entry in the category the judges will use their professional opinion in determining placement. Prize money donated in part by the Holden Chamber of Commerce, and available to winners at pick-up.




