

## Health benefits

Altered pets have a much lower risk of reproductive cancers and generally live longer lives. Females will not go in heat (eliminating the messiness and anxious behavior associated with a cycle) or experience any complications during birth. Spayed females have less risk of mammary cancer and no risk of uterine infection or cancer. Males are less likely to engage in undesirable behaviors such as urine marking, humping, aggression and roaming to seek out a mate.

## Cost benefits

The initial cost of altering your pet is returned in multiples later in life by not having to treat dangerous cancers or care for litters of pets. With subsidized fees at Pets Alive, you cannot afford to NOT have your pet spayed or neutered.

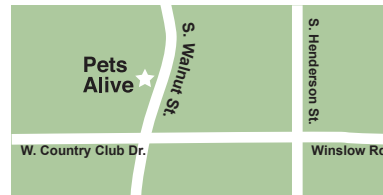

## Spay/Neuter

Pets may be spayed or neutered as early as 2-months provided they weigh at least 2 lbs.

Altered pets .....	\$5 per pet
Unaltered pets .....	additional \$15 per pet
<i>Consistent with our mission, the unaltered fee applies to pets 5-months and older that have not been spayed or neutered. This fee can be applied to the spay/neuter surgery fee within 1 year of payment.</i>

## Wellness

### Heartworm prevention

**Heartgard Plus** \$36–\$44/6-month supply or \$9/single dose

**Sentinel Spectrum** \$36–\$51/6-month supply or \$9/single dose

*Pets Alive only sells heartworm preventive medications for patients that have been heartworm tested during surgery or at the vaccination clinic.*

### Flea and tick prevention

**EasySpot** (cats only) \$28.88/3-month supply or \$12.83/single dose

**Parastar** (dogs only) \$29.95/3-month supply or \$13.90/single dose

**Frontline** (cats/dogs) \$49.74–\$51.35/3-month supply or \$20.32/single dose

**Revolution** (cats only) \$37–\$48/3-month supply or \$17/single dose

**Capstar** (cats and dogs) \$5 per pill
