

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I get a plate for a leased vehicle?

Yes.

Can I get a plate for a commercial vehicle or motorcycle?

Sorry, no.

Can I choose letters and numbers? (ex. CN39)

No, numbers only.

Can I get a low number plate?

We will be holding all plates under 100 unless requested by the family of a fallen officer. We will be doing something special with this plate and will make an announcement. Check back at: www.massachusettslawenforcementsupport.com

Can I get any number I request?

No. I can only give out plates 1-3000. Anything over 3000 will be given out by the RMV and please note they do not take requests.

Can you put a "0" in front of the numbers? (ex 0305)

No. 0305 will print as 305

Can anyone get these?

Yes, everyone who supports law enforcement is encouraged to get these.

What if my check expires during the process?

We do not deposit the checks until the 3000 applications are accepted. If your check expires before this time I will email you to send another check and shred the expired check. You may also leave the date blank should you choose.

How long until I can get my plate?

This will depend on how quickly we gather the 3000 applications so please spread the word! Once we get the 3000 applications it will take 3 months to produce and you will be notified once yours is available at the RMV.
